To improve your same-day surgical experience, we have partnered with Simple Admit. Simple Admit is a secure web-based service that empowers you to go online and submit your demographic and insurance data, along with a complete health history.

On the day of your procedure, please bring your identification, insurance card(s), and form of payment. Please contact your insurance company to verify that pre-authorization or other information is not required prior to your surgery.

The surgery scheduler will determine and notify you about the time of your procedure the day prior to your appointment. The surgery center is a separate entity from your physician's office and will bill you directly for services provided. Payment is to be made directly to the surgery center for these services. Payment may be expected at the time of service. For any billing questions regarding the surgery center, please call 208-960-0870.

- 1. Medicare patients prepare to make your copay. If you are covered by insurance, we require you pay your copay or a portion of your deductible with a minimum of \$100 surgical deposit payable before your procedure. If you are a self-pay patient, the total amount is due three (3) days prior to your procedure unless other arrangements have been made.
- 2. If you are a Medicaid patient, no payment is required.
- 3. If you are scheduled to receive anesthesia other than local agents, the anesthesia provider will visit with you prior to surgery. The anesthesia service is billed separately.
- 4. If the surgery center sends out any tissue from your surgery for pathology examination, you will receive a bill directly from the pathology lab.
